The following cost centers are for state agencies claiming federal matching funds through the Single State Agency (SSA) for state programs not administered by the SSA:

## 0001-M01-401-2199-01 State Public Defender (SPD) Indigent Parent Defense Funding

The lowa Department of Human Services (DHS) will facilitate the procurement of appropriate IV-E funding for the following non-DHS administered program:

1. The SPD shall coordinate the provision of representation to all indigent parents and children in juvenile proceedings pursuant to Iowa Code §§ 13B, 815, and 232.

2. The representation provided by the SPD is limited to independent legal representation by an attorney for a child who is a candidate for title IV-E foster care or in foster care and his/her parent to prepare for and participate in all stages of foster care legal proceedings, such as court hearings related to a child's removal from the home. Attorneys for parents and children will provide independent representation of their clients consistent with their ethical obligations.

Billings received from the State Public Defender will be applied to PP17 – Foster Care Administration Title IV-E, 50% FFP, after the application of the current quarter IV-E Population Eligibility Rate (PER) for the statewide foster family population. See Appendix F.2. The SSA will pass-through the federal funding for the SPD program per the terms of a fully executed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
