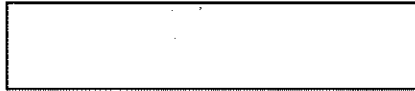

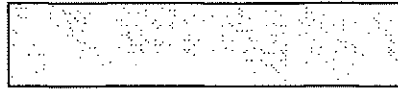

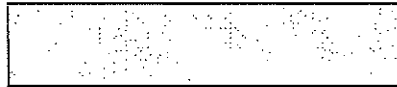

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order will allot funds previously awarded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Division of the U.S. Coast Guard for the Recreation Boating Safety program and a portion of unencumbered balance forward in the Snowmobile Enforcement Fund, the Landowner Relations Fund, the ATV Enforcement Fund, and the Warden Service accounts. These funds are to be used for the purchase of an intoxilyzer used in the aid of prosecuting cases involving operation of ATVs, snowmobiles, and boats while under the influence and will also be used to purchase a three-dimensional digital scanner that will be used for incident and crime scene documentation. Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the Department's ability to properly and efficiently document the reconstruction of crime scenes, as well as limiting the Department's ability to quickly and efficiently administer a breathalyzer test on individuals operating ATVs, snowmobiles, and boats illegally.

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward in the Bureau of Marine Patrol (BMP) Joint Enforcement Agreement-NOAA account to purchase a replacement outboard motor for a Marine Patrol vessel. Funding for this replacement engine is granted by the Department of Commerce, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, National Marine Fisheries Service, Office of Law Enforcement to be implemented in the Joint Enforcement Agreement for the 2021 and 2022 award. This vessel is a law enforcement and emergency response boat. The ongoing failure of the existing outboard motor could result in the vessel becoming inoperable and would hamper Patrol's response to an emergency. Failure to allot these funds will have a detrimental impact to the Bureau of Marine Patrol's enforcement and public safety efforts.

Program activities are focused on conducting timely inspections of proposed lease sites, conducting biosecurity audits, reviewing proposed regulatory changes by the Department of Environmental Protection for finfish lease monitoring and addressing disease issues as they occur. Failure to approve this order will have a negative impact on the department's ability to administer the aquaculture program.
