Dear Senator Hickman, Representative Supica and Members of the Committee,

Maine election law, Title 21-A section 675, requires the Secretary of State to report annually "the number and type of reports of threats to or harassment of public officials received by the Secretary of State during the previous calendar year." This report covers calendar year 2022.

We received two reports by public officials of threats or harassment while conducting state or municipal elections in the State last year. Upon investigation, one of those reports was referred to law enforcement for investigation and then referred to the Office of Attorney General, which declined prosecution. The local election official has now expressed that the law enforcement contact with the voter was sufficient and prosecution unnecessary. A second report, upon consultation with the Office of Attorney General, was determined to fall short of conduct prohibited by 21-A M.R.S. § 674(2)(E).

Additionally, we are pleased to report that we partnered with the Cybersecurity Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and the FBI to provide de-escalation training for all interested municipal clerks. We intend to continue to provide security training to our local election officials on an ongoing basis.
