An Act To Increase the State's Share of Retired Teachers' Health Insurance Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3,** ¶C, as amended by PL 2005, c. 457, Pt. TT, §1, is further amended to read:
 - C. Forty percent from August 1, 2003 to December 31, 2005; and
- **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3, ¶D,** as amended by PL 2005, c. 457, Pt. TT, §2, is further amended to read:
 - D. Forty-five percent afterfrom December 31, 2005-to December 31, 2006;
 - **Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3,** ¶**E** is enacted to read:
 - E. Fifty percent from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007; and
 - **Sec. 4. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§3,** ¶**F** is enacted to read:
 - F. Fifty-five percent after December 31, 2007.

SUMMARY

This bill increases the State's contribution for health insurance for retired educators from 45% to 50% from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007 and 55% after December 31, 2007.
