Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 2nd blocked paragraph by striking out the first sentence (page 1, lines 28 to 30 in L.D.) and inserting the following: '~~A municipality may not receive a reimbursement payment under this section that would exceed an amount determined by calculating the tree growth tax loss less the municipal savings in educational costs attributable to reduced state valuation.~~'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in subparagraph 4 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "land" the following: 'and the average value of tree growth land'

### SUMMARY

This amendment deletes language that is inconsistent with the changes in the bill and inserts language in the definition of "reduced tree growth valuation" that was inadvertently omitted.
