An Act To Clarify the Scope of Conservation Programs with Respect to Electricity Use

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3211-A, sub-§1, ¶D,** as enacted by PL 2001, c. 624, §4, is amended to read:
 - D. "Conservation programs" means programs developed by the commission pursuant to this section designed to reduce inefficient electricity use. <u>Conservation programs may also result in savings in nonelectric fuels that are incidental to electricity savings.</u>

SUMMARY

This bill clarifies that conservation programs administered by the Public Utilities Commission may result in savings in nonelectric fuels that are incidental to electricity savings.
