## An Act To Establish a "Do Not Fax" List

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1496, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 758, is amended to read:

2. Prohibition. No person may initiate:

A. The unsolicited transmission of a telefacsimile message:

(1) Seeking charitable contributions; or

(2) Promoting real property, goods or services for purchase or rent by the recipient of such a message-; or

B. The unsolicited transmission of a telefacsimile message to a telephone number that is listed on a "Do Not Fax" list of numbers maintained by the Office of the Attorney General.

Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §1496, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 758, is amended to read:

**3. Exception.** Subsection 2, paragraph A, does not apply if the person initiating the transmission and the recipient have a contractual or business relationship and no request to cease any such transmission has been made by the recipient in writing or by telefacsimile message to the person initiating the transmission.

**Sec. 3. "Do Not Fax" List.** The Office of the Attorney General shall establish a "Do Not Fax" list of telephone numbers in this State of persons who do not want unsolicited telefacsimile transmissions. This list must be published in a form that is available to those initiating telefacsimile transmissions in order to allow them to ascertain if a telephone number is prohibited.
