Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in paragraph C in subparagraph (5) (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "offenses" the following: 'within a 15-year period'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that the new Class B crime of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence 6 or more times is limited by a 15-year lookback period, which is 5 years more than the current lookback period for operating under the influence offenses but less than the lifetime lookback proposed in the bill.
