Amend the bill in section 1 in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "equitable:" the following: 'Notwithstanding the 3-mile seaward boundary of the town of Old Orchard Beach, the islands of Bluff and Stratton remain as part of the city of Saco.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the islands of Bluff and Stratton remain as part of the City of Saco despite being within the 3-mile seaward boundary of the Town of Old Orchard Beach.
