Amend the bill in section 1 in §221 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>until birth</u>"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §226 in subsection 1 in the first 2 lines (page 4, lines 4 and 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", in committing assault on an unborn child,"

## SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee and makes 2 drafting changes. First, it strikes language "until birth" in the definition of "unborn child," as this language is not relevant to the rest of the definition. Second, it strikes redundant language in the crime of aggravated assault on an unborn child.
