Fiscal Detail and Notes

Additional costs to local school administrative units (SAU's) to have one person designated to serve as the food service director and the ability of the local SAU's to absorb those costs within existing resources can not be determined at this time and will depend on the qualifications for food service directors established by the Department of Education by rule. Information provided by the department indicates that 130 of the 184 total SAU's currently report someone as a food service director. The remaining 54 SAU's have someone that performs the duties, but that person may have another job title or perform other primary functions in addition to overseeing food service.

Additional costs to the Department of Education associated with rulemaking can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
