The required local activities in this bill may represent a State mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, municipalities may not be required to implement these changes.

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The Department of Environmental Protection will require a General Fund appropriation of \$95,466 in FY 2013-14 and \$97,116 in FY 2014-15 and an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$2,078 in both FY 2013-14 and FY 2014-15 for one part-time Office Associate I position and associated administrative costs related to the meteorological tower construction or installation notification requirements.

The Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry will require a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$2,500 in fiscal year 2013-14 for rulemaking costs, including printing, advertising and room rental.
