Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Health and Human Services will require General Fund appropriations of \$53,546 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$107,093 in fiscal year 2018-19 to increase reimbursement rates for chiropractic services for manipulative treatments to no less than \$30 per treatment. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match.
