## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations totaling \$4,000,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2019-20 to the Adult Education program within the Department of Education. Of that amount, \$1,300,000 per year is provided to increase the adult education subsidy to local school units that operate adult education programs and \$2,700,000 per year is provided as targeted funds to improve the capacity of local adult education programs to meet students' academic and work readiness and training needs.
