Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the one half-time Labor & Safety Inspector position and the ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$36,338 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$49,739 in fiscal year 2024-25 to the Regulation and Enforcement program within the Department of Labor included in the bill to support the anticipated increase in workload to ensure compliance with new regulations regarding disclosure and record keeping by employers of employee pay information. The Department of Labor has indicated that without additional staffing resources it will need to prioritize enforcement activities.
