2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11152, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

8. Junior hunters; antlerless deer. A junior hunter who possesses a valid resident
license may take an antlerless deer during the open season on deer. The department shall
designate which wildlife management districts are open to the taking of antlerless deer by
a junior hunter based on the department's management of the deer herd statewide.

- 8 This bill allows a junior hunter to lawfully take an antlerless deer during the open 9 season on deer. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall designate which 10 wildlife management districts are open to the taking of antlerless deer by a junior hunter.
