1       **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2             **Sec. 1. 20-A MRS §6214** is enacted to read:

3       **§6214. School performance grading**

4             The department may not use a school performance grading system that uses a single  
5       letter grade to measure school performance based on student proficiency standards  
6       established under this chapter.

7   **SUMMARY**

8             This bill prohibits the Department of Education from using a school performance  
9       grading system that uses a single letter grade to measure school performance.
