## **Resolve, Directing the Department of Environmental Protection To Amend Its Rules Regarding Snow Dumps**

Resolved: That the Department of Environmental 2 Protection shall amend its rules regarding snow dumps to exempt from the waste 3 discharge licensing requirement any snow dump operation controlled by a municipality 4 for the primary purpose of removing accumulated snow from public rights-of-way for the 5 safety and convenience of the traveling public.

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## SUMMARY

7 This resolve directs the Department of Environmental Protection to amend its rules 8 regarding snow dumps to exempt from the waste discharge licensing requirement any 9 snow dump operation controlled by a municipality for the primary purpose of removing 10 accumulated snow from public rights-of-way for the safety and convenience of the 11 traveling public.
