1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §5401, sub-§17, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 572, Pt. A, §5, is
amended to read:

4 17. Rules. The department may adopt rules to implement the provisions of this 5 section. A rule authorized or provisionally adopted by the department pursuant to this subsection or Title 29 A, section 2311 after January 1, 2008 that concerns the 6 7 transportation of public preschool students is a major substantive rule and subject to legislative review in accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A. An 8 amendment to a rule adopted pursuant to this subsection or Title 29-A, section 2311 prior 9 10 to January 1, 2008 is considered a major substantive rule when the amendment concerns the transportation of public preschool students, and it is subject to legislative review in 11 accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A. 12

Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2311, as amended by PL 2007, c. 572, Pt. A, §17, is further
amended to read:

15 **§2311. Rules**

16 The Commissioner of Education may adopt or amend rules consistent with this Title 17 and in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, concerning school bus 18 construction, equipment, operation and identification. Rules adopted pursuant to this 19 section that concern the transportation of public preschool students are major substantive 20 rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

This bill removes from the education laws rule-making language regarding the transportation of public preschool students.
