1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §10014 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§10014. Student health fees</u>
4 5 6 7	A postsecondary institution may assess a student a student health fee only if the student has expressly agreed to pay the fee. For purposes of this section, "student health fee" means any fee separately charged to a student for health services, including, but not limited to, access to a health center.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill prohibits a postsecondary institution from assessing a student a student health fee unless the student has expressly agreed to pay the fee.
