2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

4 **HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**
5 **Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention**

6 Initiative: Provides ongoing funds to the HIV, sexually transmitted diseases and viral
7 hepatitis program to provide screening and prevention services and diagnostic and
8 treatment services for individuals throughout the State who are uninsured and without
9 covered access to such services and who are at risk in accordance with criteria established
10 by the program.
