2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10853, sub-§16 is enacted to read:

16. Resident 16 or 17 years of age in custody of the Department of Health and
Human Services. A complimentary license to fish may be issued to any resident 16 or
17 years of age who is in the custody of the Department of Health and Human Services
under Title 19-A, chapter 55 and Title 22, chapter 1071, upon application to the
commissioner. This complimentary license remains valid for the duration of the
Department of Health and Human Services' custody of the resident, if the license is not
revoked or suspended.

10 SUMMARY

11 This bill allows a complimentary fishing license to be issued to any resident 16 or 17 12 years of age who is in the custody of the Department of Health and Human Services.
