3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to amend the laws governing the Maine Public Employees
6 Retirement System to provide the same retirement benefits as are provided to law
7 enforcement officers to state employees working in law enforcement, including these job
8 classifications:

- 9 1. Emergency dispatchers;
- 10 2. Staff in the Maine State Police computer crimes unit;
- 11 3. Staff in the Maine State Police Crime Laboratory;
- 12 4. Law enforcement staff at the Attorney General's office; and
- 13 5. Forest rangers.
