1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **CONCEPT DRAFT**

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to enact measures designed to facilitate the ability of so-called
6 "one-industry towns" to plan for, and recover from, the closure of that one industry. The
7 measures proposed by the bill may include, but are not limited to:

8 1. The imposition of a fee on any ancillary commodity produced by the industry,
9 such as hydropower produced by a mill, and remitting the amount of the fee to the town;

10 2. A requirement that municipalities that are reliant on a single industry develop,
11 with representatives of the industry, a long-term plan for the industry and any ancillary
12 commodity produced by the industry; and

13 3. A requirement that an industry provide municipal officials written notice of its
14 plan to terminate its business at least 90 days prior to the intended termination.
