## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1406, sub-§4, as amended by PL 2011, c. 356, §19, is
further amended to read:

4 4. Renewals. Prior to the expiration of a license to operate a motor vehicle, the
5 Secretary of State shall send the license holder a renewal notice. The Secretary of State
6 may not require a birth certificate or other documentation to prove the citizenship of a
7 person renewing a license under this chapter.

## SUMMARY

9 This bill prohibits the Secretary of State from requiring a birth certificate or other 10 documentation to prove the citizenship of a person renewing a driver's license issued by 11 the State.
