- 1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next
  fiscal year; and
- 5 **Whereas,** this legislation provides adjustments to appropriations from the General 6 Fund for certain expenditures of the judicial branch for the fiscal years ending June 30, 7 2016 and June 30, 2017; and
- 8 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 9 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 10 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 11 therefore,
- 12 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 13 Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §1556, sub-§2, ¶I is enacted to read:
- 14I. The hourly rate of compensation for the guardian ad litem may not be less than the15rate of compensation established by the Maine Commission on Indigent Legal16Services pursuant to section 1804, subsection 3, paragraph F. Nothing in this17paragraph prohibits the court from establishing maximum fees and other reasonable18requirements relating to guardian ad litem billing and compensation.
- Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

- 22 Courts Supreme, Superior and District 0063
- Initiative: Provides funding for the child protective guardian ad litem hourly rate increase from \$50 per hour to \$60 per hour to be consistent with the rate paid to attorneys appointed to represent parents.

5	1. It provides funding for the guardian ad litem hourly rate increase from \$50 per		
6	hour to \$60 per hour to be consistent with the rate paid to court-appointed counsel.		
7	2. It provides funding for an increase in the workweek of certain judicial branch		
8	employees from 37.5 hours per week to 40 hours per week.		
9	3. It provides funding for an increase in fees charged by the Department of		
10	Administrative and Financial Services, Office of Information Technology to the judicial		
11	branch.		
12	4. It deappropriates unused feasibility study funds.
