4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to create a program using a \$5,000,000 fund to help employers
6 lower their energy costs through energy efficiency and weatherization initiatives. This
7 program would be modeled after the Governor's Jobs Initiative Program administered by
8 the Department of Labor's bureau of employment services, which provides financial
9 assistance to employers that are expanding, reorganizing or locating in the State or are
10 training new or current employees to upgrade worker skills.
