1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13104, sub-§15**, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 437, §1, is
3 amended to read:

4 **15. Reciprocity.** The commissioner may allow a nonresident to operate in this State
5 a snowmobile that is not registered in this State during one 3-consecutive-day period, 2
6 days of which are weekend days, annually if:

7 A. The nonresident's snowmobile has a valid registration from another state; and

8 B. The nonresident's state of residency allows a snowmobile registered in Maine to
9 be operated in that state for a period of time of at least 3 consecutive days without
10 being registered in that state.

11 This subsection may not be construed to authorize the operation of a snowmobile in a
12 manner contrary to this chapter except as provided in this subsection.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill makes permanent the reciprocal agreement between Maine and other states
16 regarding a snowmobile weekend, which by current law is repealed on October 1, 2013.
