## An Act To Create a 5-year Statute of Limitations for Environmental Violations

## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §347-A, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 337, §1, is repealed
and the following enacted in its place:

8. Limitations on enforcement actions. Notwithstanding Title 14, section 752, any
 enforcement action for civil or administrative penalties brought by the department or the
 Attorney General for a violation of this Title, of rules adopted under this Title or of the
 terms or conditions of a license, permit or order issued by the department must be
 initiated within 5 years of the date of the violation.

- 10 This bill requires enforcement actions for violations of environmental laws to be 11 brought by the Department of Environmental Protection or the Attorney General within 5 12 years of the date of the violation.
