**Resolve, Directing the Department of Transportation and the Maine  
Turnpike Authority To Erect Highway Signs for Thornton  
Academy**

1           **Sec. 1. Signs placed for Thornton Academy. Resolved:** That,  
2 notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 1912-C, the Maine  
3 Turnpike Authority shall place directional signs to Thornton Academy in the City of Saco  
4 on the portion of Interstate 95 designated as the Maine Turnpike at the northbound and  
5 southbound exits of the highway that are located closest to Thornton Academy and that  
6 the Department of Transportation shall place directional signs on the portion of Interstate  
7 195 closest to Thornton Academy in each direction; and be it further

8           **Sec. 2. Costs. Resolved:** That Thornton Academy shall assume all costs  
9 associated with the directional signs described in section 1.

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## SUMMARY

11           This resolve directs the Maine Turnpike Authority to place directional signs to  
12 Thornton Academy in the City of Saco on the Maine Turnpike at the northbound and  
13 southbound exits of the highway that are located closest to Thornton Academy, and the  
14 Department of Transportation to place directional signs on Interstate 195 in each  
15 direction. The resolve directs Thornton Academy to assume all costs associated with the  
16 signs.
