1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1059 is enacted to read:
3	§1059. Discharging a firearm near a state-owned boat launching ramp
4 5 6	<b>1.</b> A person is guilty of discharging a firearm near a state-owned boat launching ramp if the person discharges a firearm within 300 feet of a state-owned boat launching ramp.
7 8	2. This section does not apply to a law enforcement officer in the performance of the law enforcement officer's duties.
9	3. Discharging a firearm near a state-owned boat launching ramp is a Class E crime.
10	SUMMARY
11 12	This bill makes discharging a firearm within 300 feet of a state-owned boat launching ramp a Class E crime.
