### An Act To Facilitate Patient Education

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2142, sub-§3**, as amended by PL 1993, c. 331, §1, is further  
3 amended to read:

4 **3. Home health care provider.** "Home health care provider" means any business  
5 entity or subdivision thereof, whether public or private, proprietary or not for profit, that  
6 is engaged in providing acute, restorative, rehabilitative, maintenance, preventive or  
7 health promotion services through professional nursing or another therapeutic service,  
8 such as physical therapy, home health aides, nurse assistants, medical social work,  
9 nutritionist services or personal care services, either directly or through contractual  
10 agreement, in a client's place of residence. This term does not apply to any sole  
11 practitioner providing private duty nursing services or other restorative, rehabilitative,  
12 maintenance, preventive or health promotion services in a client's place of residence or to  
13 municipal entities providing health promotion services in a client's place of residence.  
14 This term does not apply to a federally qualified health center or a rural health clinic as  
15 defined in 42 United States Code, Section 1395x, subsection (aa) (1993) that is delivering  
16 case management services or health education in a client's place of residence. This term  
17 does not apply to a registered nurse educator. For purposes of this subsection, "registered  
18 nurse educator" means a registered nurse licensed under Title 32, chapter 31 who  
19 provides postprescription training to a patient or caregiver in a patient's place of residence  
20 when the registered nurse educator does not provide health care services, does not deliver  
21 the prescription drug, does not touch the patient, does not administer the prescription drug  
22 to the patient and does not seek payment from the patient, caregiver or any health care  
23 payor. Beginning October 1, 1991, "home health care provider" includes any business  
24 entity or subdivision thereof, whether public or private, proprietary or nonprofit, that is  
25 engaged in providing speech pathology services.

26 **SUMMARY**

27 This bill exempts a registered nurse educator who provides postprescription training  
28 to a patient or caregiver in a patient's place of residence from the laws governing the  
29 licensure of home health care providers.
