2 **Insurance to establish a consistent workers' compensation classification for**
3 **pharmacies. Resolved:** That, notwithstanding the provisions of the Maine Revised
4 Statutes, Title 24-A, chapter 25, subchapter 2-B, the Department of Professional and
5 Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance shall establish a workers' compensation
6 insurance business classification for pharmacies so that the workers' compensation
7 insurance rate for an employee of a pharmacy located within a larger retail store is
8 identical to the workers' compensation insurance rate for an employee of a stand-alone
9 pharmacy.

SUMMARY

11 This resolve requires the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation,
12 Bureau of Insurance to establish a workers' compensation business classification for
13 pharmacies so that the workers' compensation insurance rate for employees of a
14 pharmacy located within a larger retail store is identical to the workers' compensation
15 insurance rate for employees of a stand-alone pharmacy.
