**Whereas,** the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation is prepared to begin a comprehensive review of the dental practice laws in order to recommend changes to streamline the licensure and scope of practice provisions in a timely fashion and report to the Second Regular Session of the 127th Legislature; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

**Sec. 1. Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation to study the dental practice laws and recommend changes. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation, or the commissioner's designee, in consultation with interested parties, shall conduct a study of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 16 and any laws associated with the provisions of that chapter and recommend changes that streamline the licensure and scope of practice provisions to more accurately reflect the delivery and practice settings of dental services in this State; and be it further
