COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 900, L.D. 1209, Bill, “An Act Regarding Stops of All-terrain Vehicles and Snowmobiles by Law Enforcement Officers”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph G in the 8th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "is being operated more than 20 feet from" and inserting the following: 'leaves'

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph H in the 7th line (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "is not being operated on" and inserting the following: 'leaves'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. It amends the bill by providing that once an ATV or snowmobile leaves the Maine Trails System, the ATV or snowmobile may be stopped by law enforcement for any reason.
