COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 170, L.D. 509, Bill, “An Act To Allocate at Least 10 Percent of Antlerless Deer Permits Available in Each Wildlife Management District to Hunters 70 Years of Age and Older”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Allocate at Least 5 Percent of Antlerless Deer Permits Available in Each Wildlife Management District to Hunters 70 Years of Age and Older'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 9 in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10%" and inserting the following: '5%'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, decreases the percentage of antlerless deer permits issued in a wildlife management district to eligible hunters 70 years of age and older from 10%, as provided in the bill, to 5%.
