Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph R in the 2nd line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "who elect to participate in the 1998 Special Plan"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 2 in the 8th line (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "after June 30, 2022 for employees" and inserting the following: 'any employee'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 5. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§3, ¶A, as amended by PL 2021, c. 474, §7, is further amended by amending subparagraph (1) to read:

(1) Service credit purchased by repayment of an earlier refund of accumulated contributions following termination of service is included only to the extent that time to which the refund relates was served after June 30, 1998 and before September 1, 2002 for employees identified in subsection 1, paragraphs A and B; after June 30, 1998 for employees identified in subsection 1, paragraphs C to H; after December 31, 1999 for employees identified in subsection 1, paragraphs I to K; after June 30, 2020 for employees identified in subsection 1, paragraphs N to P; and after September 30, 2021 for employees identified in subsection 1, paragraph Q in any one or a combination of the capacities specified in subsection 1. Service credit may be purchased for service by an employee identified in subsection 1, paragraphs L ~~and~~, M and R regardless of when performed; and'

Amend the bill in section 7 in paragraph B in the first line (page 3, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting the following: 'and.'

Amend the bill in section 7 in paragraph B in the first line (page 3, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "F" the following: 'and G'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

1 **'Sec. 8. 5 MRSA §17851-A, sub-§4, ¶G** is enacted to read:

2 G. The service retirement benefit of a member to whom subsection 1, paragraph R
 3 applies and who qualifies for service retirement benefits under subsection 2 must be
 4 computed under section 17852, subsection 1, paragraph A on the basis of all of the
 5 member's creditable service in the capacity specified in subsection 1, paragraph R,
 6 regardless of when that creditable service was earned, except that for a member
 7 qualifying under subsection 2, paragraph B:

8 (1) If the member had 10 years of service on July 1, 1993, the benefit must be
 9 reduced as provided in section 17852, subsection 3, paragraphs A and B for each
 10 year the member's age precedes 55 years of age; or

11 (2) If the member had fewer than 10 years of creditable service on July 1, 1993,
 12 the benefit must be reduced by 6% for each year that the member's age precedes
 13 55 years of age.'

14 Amend the bill by striking out all of section 9 and inserting the following:

15 **'Sec. 9. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and

29 **SUMMARY**

30 This amendment removes the election that employees in the Office of Chief Medical
 31 Examiner within the Department of the Attorney General must make to participate in the
 32 1998 Special Plan of the Maine Public Employees Retirement System. It also provides that
 33 the service retirement benefit for an employee in the office must be computed on the basis
 34 of all of the member's creditable service, regardless of when that service was earned.
