COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 672, L.D. 1036, “An Act to Require All Police Officers to Carry Naloxone Hydrochloride When on Duty”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Require All Uniformed Patrol Officers to Carry Naloxone Hydrochloride When on Duty'**

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2353, sub-§3-A** is enacted to read:

**3-A. Administration, dispensing and carrying of naloxone hydrochloride by law enforcement officers.** The Commissioner of Public Safety shall adopt rules requiring training on administration and dispensing of naloxone hydrochloride by law enforcement officers who perform duties as uniformed patrol officers and requiring such officers to carry naloxone hydrochloride while on duty. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill and changes the title. It requires the Commissioner of Public Safety to adopt routine technical rules requiring training on the use and administration of naloxone hydrochloride for all law enforcement officers who perform duties as uniformed patrol officers and requiring such officers to carry naloxone hydrochloride while on duty.
