SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 1371, L.D. 1853, Bill, “An Act To Improve Environmental Oversight and Streamline Permitting for Mining in Maine”

Amend the amendment in section 23 in §490-OO by adding after subsection 6 the following:

7. County approval. A mining permit may not be issued under this section unless the proposed mining operation has been approved by a referendum of the voters of the county or counties in which the proposed mining operation is located.'

This amendment provides that a mining permit may not be issued unless the proposed mining operation has been approved by a referendum of the voters of the county or counties in which the proposed mining operation is located.
