SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 1191, L.D. 1619, Bill, “An Act To Amend the Law Governing Conflicts of Interest with Respect to the Public Utilities Commission”

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §108-B by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 27 to 30 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'4. Compensation. In the event of a temporary appointment under this section, the commission shall provide administrative support to the temporary commissioner and compensate the temporary commissioner for the hours spent at the commission working on a proceeding at an hourly rate that is computed by dividing the annual salary of a commissioner, established in Title 2, section 6-A, subsection 2, by 2,080 hours.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies with more detail the compensation that will be provided to a temporary commissioner.
