HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 592, L.D. 945, “An Act to Allow Maine Families to Increase Their Savings by Removing Asset Limits for Eligibility for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program”

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph A in the 4th line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "may impose an asset limit of not less than" and inserting the following: 'shall impose an asset limit of'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Department of Health and Human Services to impose an asset limit of \$10,000 per family for the purpose of determining eligibility for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program.
