HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 719, L.D. 1884, Bill, “An Act To Create a Community Protection Order To Allow Courts To Prevent High-risk Individuals from Possessing Firearms”

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part C and inserting the following:

'PART C

Sec. C-1. Entry of court orders. Until a case management system for the judicial branch is fully operational, any orders issued by a court pursuant to this Act must be forwarded on the same business day by e-mail to the Department of Public Safety for entry into the electronic records management system maintained by the department.

PART D

Sec. D-1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

10 department. This requirement expires once a case management system for the judicial
11 branch is fully operational.
