Resolve, To Deauthorize the Naming of the Bridge over Pattagumpus Stream

(EMERGENCY)

1	Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
3	Whereas, Resolve 2009, chapter 160 gave the Department of Transportation the
4	authority to designate the new bridge over Pattagumpus Stream in the Town of Medway;
5	and
6	Whereas, the wrong bridge was named in the resolve; and
7	Whereas, it is imperative that the directive to the Department of Transportation be
8	revoked as soon as possible; and
9	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within
10	the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as
11	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
12	therefore, be it
13	Sec. 1. Resolve 2009, c. 160, repealed. Resolved: That Resolve 2009, c. 160 is
14	repealed.
15	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this
16	legislation takes effect when approved.
17	SUMMARY
18	This resolve repeals the directive to the Department of Transportation to designate
19	the new bridge over Pattagumpus Stream in the Town of Medway the Nicatou Bridge.
