7	This amendment changes the title and replaces the bill to provide that school
8	administrative units may employ or contract with qualified licensed individuals to
9	provide related services required to assist children with disabilities to benefit from their
10	special education programs. The amendment also directs the Commissioner of Education
11	to amend the Department of Education rules in Chapter 101: Maine Unified Special
12	Education Regulation Birth to Age Twenty to clarify that a person licensed as a marriage
13	and family therapist is qualified to serve as a qualified evaluator and a qualified licensed
14	contractor.
