4	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment requires a
5	retail seller of propane gas to notify customers in writing if the seller charges a minimum
6	usage fee or tank rental fee and prohibits the seller from changing the fee without first
7	notifying the customer in writing. It also requires a retail seller of propane gas, upon a
8	change of ownership over a residential dwelling serviced by the retail seller, to verify that
9	the new owner of the residential dwelling agrees to accept services from the retail seller of
10	propane gas.
