Restrict the use of certain neonicotinoids for outdoor use. 16 17 Resolved: That, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 7, section 610, the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Board of Pesticides Control shall 18 change the classification of any product containing the active ingredient dinotefuran, 19 20 clothianidin, imidacloprid or thiamethoxam used for application in outdoor residential 21 landscapes such as on lawn, turf or ornamental vegetation to restricted use. Products used 22 for preserving wood, controlling or treating indoor insects, controlling or treating insects 23 outside around structural foundations and other parts of structures and treating pets, as defined under Title 7, section 712, subsection 16, are specifically exempt from the 24 25 classification change to restricted use under this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2 A.' 26 27 Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 28 29 **SUMMARY** 30 This amendment directs the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, 31 Board of Pesticides Control to change the classification of any product containing certain 32 neonicotinoids used for application in outdoor residential landscapes such as on lawn, turf 33 or ornamental vegetation from general use to restricted use. The amendment adds products 34 used for controlling or treating insects outside around structural foundations and other parts
