3	SUMMARY
4	Current law prohibits a person from making a bad faith assertion of patent
5	infringement against another person. A person who does make a bad faith assertion may
6	have to pay remedies awarded by the court, including equitable relief, damages, costs and
7	fees and punitive damages; however, the law exempts persons seeking relief pursuant to
8	35 United States Code, Section 271(e)(2) or 42 United States Code, Section 262 from the
9	law prohibiting bad faith assertions of patent infringement, which may include businesses
.0	such as pharmaceutical companies. This bill removes the exemption.
