Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §1215, as amended by PL 1991, c. 528, Pt. E, §13 and affected by Pt. RRR and amended by c. 591, Pt. E, §13, is further amended to read:
§1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors
A juror is entitled to paid mileage at the rate of $\frac{15}{\sqrt{44}}$ per mile for travel expenses from the juror's residence to the place of holding court and return and to compensation at the rate of \$10 \frac{\$32}{}\$ for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.
SUMMARY
This bill increases the mileage reimbursement for citizens who serve as jurors from 15ϕ per mile to 44ϕ per mile and the per diem compensation to \$32 per day, the amount paid to Legislators for meals.
