2 3 4	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §456, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C, §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:
5	§456. Rescue services
6 7 8	Each county may provide rescue services through the sheriff's department and deputies except that York County may provide for rescue services pursuant to section 457.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill allows York County Government to provide rescue services pursuant to the law governing counties' provision of ambulance services.
