In any year in which a law authorizing a new gambling facility that operates slot machines or table games takes effect, submit to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over gambling matters by the immediately following October 15th legislation that distributes 50% of the net gambling revenue to the operator of the gambling facility and 50% to the General Fund.

17 18 19 20	This bill directs the Gambling Control Board within the Department of Public Safety to submit legislation regarding the distribution of net gambling revenue from table games and slot machines for any new gaming facility authorized by initiative or enactment by the Legislature.
